For example, on September 30, 2000, the guard had about 4, 048 soldiers, or 1. 3 percent of its 301, 140 drilling members, who had not been paid for 7 months or more, and on September 30, 2001, the guard had about 4, 254 soldiers, or 1. 4 percent of its 296, 430 drilling members, who had not been paid for 7 months or more.
